

The Lord sent me to bring good news, to proclaim release to the captives.



When Jesus began his public ministry in his home town, the initial reaction of the locals to his preaching was very favorable. He spoke fluently and simply but with authority and they loved his words when they first heard them. However, as time passed they felt threatened because they realized that they were being challenged to change their ways. The message of Jesus was a disturbing one and they could not accept it. When Jesus made the comment that no prophet is ever accepted in his own country he was clearly

identifying himself with the long line of prophets who suffered a similar fate. What happened that day in Nazareth was to be repeated over and over again during his ministry, with crucifixion as the inevitable final outcome. God has called us to share the challenges of this particular work and he has not promised easy success or popularity. To be good news in the world today is not an easy task but a great and new challenging experience.
