

Mark's Gospel tells us that Jesus did this throughout Galilee. Jesus' compassion and healing of the sick is a sign of the Kingdom of God. the Church prays for spiritual and physical healing, forgiveness of sins, and comfort for those who are suffering from illness. We also notice the importance of prayer in Jesus' daily life. Jesus rose early in the morning and went to a deserted place to pray. When the disciples found him, he told them that it was time to move on. We believe that in his prayers Jesus found guidance and direction from God. We also bring our decision-making to God in prayer, asking for his guidance and direction in our lives.
