# Feast of St. Anthony's Parish



Saint Anthony of Padua (*St. António de Lisboa*), born Fernando Martins de Bulhões (15 August 1195 – 13 June 1231), also known as Anthony of Lisbon, was a Portuguese Catholic priest and friar of the Franciscan Order. He was born and raised by a wealthy family in Lisbon, Portugal, and died in Padua, Italy. Noted by his contemporaries for his powerful preaching, expert knowledge of scripture, and undying

love and devotion to the poor and the sick, he was one of the most quickly canonized saints in church history. He was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church on 16 January 1946. He is also the patron saint of lost things.

# X Domenica in Tempo Ordinario



Antonio di Padova, noto in Portogallo come Antonio da Lisbona (Lisbona, 15 agosto 1195 - Padova, 13 giugno 1231), è stato un religioso e presbitero portoghese appartenente all'Ordine francescano, proclamato santo da papa Gregorio IX nel 1232 e dichiarato dottore della Chiesa nel 1946. Da principio canonico regolare a Coimbra dal 1210, poi dal 1220 frate francescano. Viaggiò molto, vivendo prima in Portogallo quindi in Italia e in Francia. Nel

1221 si recò al Capitolo Generale ad Assisi, dove vide e ascoltò di persona san Francesco d'Assisi. Terminato il capitolo, Antonio fu inviato a Montepaolo di Dovadola, nei pressi di Forlì. Fu dotato di grande umiltà, ma anche di grande sapienza e cultura, per le sue valenti doti di predicatore, mostrate per la prima volta proprio a Forlì nel 1222. Antonio fu incaricato dell'insegnamento della teologia e inviato dallo stesso san Francesco a contrastare in Francia la diffusione del movimento dei catari, che la Chiesa di Roma giudicava eretico. Fu poi trasferito a Bologna e quindi a Padova. Morì all'età di 36 anni. Rapidamente canonizzato (in meno di un anno) il suo culto è fra i più diffusi del cattolicesimo.
