Fill us with your love, O Lord, that we may rejoice and be glad.



The Gospel today, from St. Mark, tells the story of a very good young man who wants to follow Jesus and has been deeply faithful to the teachings of God in his Jewish faith. Yes when Jesus asks the young man to give up all his wealth and come and follow him, then the young man goes away sad. What a strong teaching. God is always asking things of each of us. In many

ways, we are like the rich young man: good but not totally committed. We don't know what the young man did later on. Perhaps he ended up selling everything and giving it to the poor and following Jesus. We can ask ourselves if it would make us sad to give up for the sake of following the Lord. Ideally we should be able to give up everything and follow him. Jesus does not ask to give up everything right away, but in the end we all know that we must be willing to give up everything and cling only to the Lord. Only if we continue to grow in our awareness of and acceptance of his love can we finally give up all for Him and enter the Kingdom.


