The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy.



When the blind man, Bartimaeus, hears that Jesus of Nazareth is passing by, he calls out to him, asking for help. Bartimaeus calls out to Jesus, the crowd around him tries to silence him. Yet Bartimaeus persists, calling out more loudly and with greater urgency. He will not be silenced or deterred from getting Jesus' attention. We notice how quickly the crowd's reaction changes when Jesus calls for Bartimaeus. Those who sought to quiet him now encourage him. When Jesus restores Bartimaeus's sight he simply says that Barti-

maeus's faith has saved him. Throughout Mark's Gospel, the success of Jesus' healing power has often been correlated with the faith of the person requesting Jesus' help. Once his sight has been restored, Bartimaeus follows Jesus on his way to Jerusalem. Let's open our eyes to the grace of God and come out of our blindness.

Why we sing the Responsorial Psalm?

The Psalm that follows the First Reading is



"responsorial" because of its form, not because of its function. It is designed to be sung in alternation between the psalmist and the people; thus, making it responsorial. Although it usually echoes a theme from the First Reading, it is not a "response" to the reading. In many worshipping communities, the cantor or song leader is also the psalmist.


