Repent, says the Lord; the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Often it is not what we do wrong but the things that we leave undone which prevent us from growing in the love of Christ. The real heartache is that we are guilty of sins of omission and neglect of which we are hardly even conscious. Our lack of concern for others reveals too clearly this form of personal selfishness and highlights our failure to live the Christian life to the full. Without exception each one of us needs to make a better effort in caring, sharing, loving and being available to our neighbor. Lent is an opportunity for taking a hard look at our lives and asking how do we stand before God right now. If we find that we are so caught up with material concerns that we have given a back seat to spiritual things, then we have forgotten the real purpose of why God gave us life. The challenge confronting us is to allow the grace of God to fertilize the soil around our hearts in the expectation that it will produce good fruit.
