Whoever drinks the water that I shall give him, says the Lord, will have a spring inside him, welling up for eternal life.



THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Jesus longs to give the Samaritan woman the living waters that well up to eternal life. This meeting happened at the well of Jacob, father of the Israelites and the Samaritans. But Jesus was something greater than Jacob. The Samaritans were Israelites who escaped exile when Assyria conquered the Northern Kingdom and they were worshipping at Mount Gerazim, not Jerusalem. But Jesus tells the woman that the "hour" of true worship is coming when all will worship God in Spirit and truth. Jesus' "hour" is the "appointed time" that Paul speaks of in today's Epistle: the hour of our salvation and redemption: Jesus's death and resurrection. In Jesus the enmity of Samaritans and Jews has been washed away, the dividing wall between Israel and the nations is broken down. He calls us to believe: "I am He," I came to pour out the love of God into your hearts through the Holy Spirit. Do we believe him?

Quando la donna gli chiede del messia, la risposta di Gesù non è solo "Sono io il Messia" ma "Sono io che parlo con te". Il nostro Dio è un Dio che ci viene incontro e ci parla, perché l'amore di Dio, lo Spirito Santo, cioè Dio stesso, è stato versato nei nostri cuori. Come dice ancora Gesù in questa pagina del Vangelo - viene l'ora, ed è questa, in cui i veri adoratori adoreranno il Padre in spirito e verità.
