#### SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

February 14, 2021



In today's Gospel, the man with leprosy took the initiative, approaching Jesus and asking for healing. In doing so, the leper violated the religious customs of the day by approaching a person who was clean. His request to Jesus can be interpreted as a courageous and daring act. The confidence of the leper in Jesus' ability to heal him is evident in the words of his request. While healing the man, Jesus touched him, which also violated established social norms. This is an important sign of the depth of Jesus' compassion for the man and an important statement about Jesus' interpretation of the Law of Moses.

## What Bishop Barron Is Saying About *Return*



The Church faces many challenges today, but I am convinced that America's most pressing concern is our own people's attrition.

Thirteen percent of Americans identify as former Catholics, and for everyone who converts to the Cath-

olic faith, more than six people leave. One-third of people raised Catholic no longer identify as Catholic today, and attendance at the Mass, identified by the Second Vatican Council as "the source and summit of the Christian life," continues to fall, with only a paltry 24% in the pews on any given Sunday. The statistics get worse among younger generations. One-third of the Millennial generation now claims no religious affiliation, and only 16% identify as Catholic.

Even among immigrants, as cultural assimilation takes hold of second and third generations, they leave the Church at rates similar to the general Catholic population. As many evangelists have observed, "God has no grandchildren." For the first time, each generation must meet Christ and the Church, not relying on mere cultural ambience or ethnic identification.

But while God may not have grandchildren, people do. In the face of apparent failure and heartbreak, you're asking yourself, What went wrong? Did I do enough? What more could I have done? Is there anything I can do now? How does one repair a broken relationship with Christ and the Church?

Rather than opting for despair, let's focus on the solution, using a positive emphasis on what parents, teachers, priests . . . can say and do to respond to their child's objections, rebuild relationships, and ultimately draw them back to the Church.

The 'Return' book of Brandon Vogt offers no magic-bullet guarantee that your child will come back. But you will find a complete game plan to create the best possible environment to reintroduce your child to Christ and his Church.

Therefore, if your son or daughter has left the faith, I encourage you not to give up hope, prayer and to learn many ways to reconnect with your children.
