Today's Gospel Reading consists of two parables about seeds. These parables help us discern something about the kingdom of God and our faith. In God, we live and move and have our being, but God is a mystery and his kingdom, though present, has not yet come into its fullness. Today, the Kingdom of God is present in the Church. # Tree of Righteousness

In the cryptic message of the prophet Ezekiel, long centuries before the Lord's coming, and God gave His people reason to hope. Ezekiel glimpsed a day when the Lord God would place a tree on a mountain in Israel, a tree that would "put forth branches and bear

fruit." Who could have predicted that the tree would be a cross on the hill of Calvary and that the fruit would be salvation? Ezekiel foresees salvation coming to "birds of every kind" thus, not just to the people of Israel, but also to the Gentiles. The image of a flourishing tree to describe the lives of the just. The image, again, suggests the Cross as the measure of righteousness.

The Cross is a sign of contradiction to those who would rather "flourish" in worldly terms. As St. Paul emphasizes to the Corinthians, we need courage. Our faith makes us strong, and it is proved in our deeds. He reminds us that we will be judged by the ways our faith manifests itself in works: "so that each may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil."

God, Himself will empower the works. He scattered the seed that sprang up and became the mustard tree, large enough to accommodate all the birds of the sky, just as Ezekiel had seen. He gave this doctrine to His disciples in terms they understood, and He provided a full explanation. In the sacraments, He provides still more: the grace of faith and the courage we need to live in the world as children of God. - Scott Hahn.

## MESSAGE FROM BISHOP COLLI:

RE-OPENING OF THE CHURCHES: With the Ontatio Government announcing that the province will enter STEP ONE of the reopening plan on June 11, this means that our Churches can again be open to our parishioners with a 15% capacity for Mass. As more people are vaccinated and more re-openings happen in the province, we will have a greater capacity for our churches in the next steps. Thank you for your patience and understanding, we hope to see you soon back in our parishes for Mass.
