Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary



On this feast, we praise God who has taken the sinless Virgin Mary, body and soul, into His glory. In Revelation, we find God's temple in heaven opened, and the Ark of the Covenant revealed. The most sacred item in Israel's history, the Ark, had been missing since the Temple's destruction in 586 B.C. Thus, John reports some startling news. Even more astonishing is his revelation that the sacred vessel is now a woman who is

the mother of David's royal Son, the Messiah. As we see in Revelation, the queen once again takes her place at the right hand of the Son of David at Mary's Assumption. In our second reading, today shows us why this is fitting: "in Christ shall all be brought to life, but each one in proper order." What is implicit in St. Paul's statement is revealed in Revelation. The consummation of Christ's work has begun, as is proper, with the Assumption of the queen mother. John's Apocalypse also shows the fulfillment of our Gospel. There, Mary, pregnant with Jesus, retraces the steps of David as he brought the Ark to Jerusalem. Mary "arose and went" into the hill country, just as David "arose and went" to that region. Upon Mary's arrival, Elizabeth is amazed, just as David was before Ark. The encounter causes the baby John to leap with excitement as David leapt before the Ark. And Mary stayed in the "house of Zechariah" for "three months," as the Ark remained in the "house of Obed-edom" for the same period.

Mary is the vessel of God's presence, and she is the queen mother. She reigns now in splendor with Jesus in the heavenly Jerusalem. - Scott Hahn

MESSAGE FROM BISHOP COLLI: Step 3 of Reopening of

Churches: On Friday, July 16th, we entered Step 3 of the province's reopening plan. This plan allows for full capacity of our churches, according to what proper social distancing will allow. Most probably still marking off every second pew at this time. The other safety protocols are still in place however. Masks must be worn; social distancing in and outside of church; sanitizing of hands at the doors; no congregational singing, but cantors and musicians are allowed; no shaking of hands, and Holy Communion only in the hand. No children's liturgies at this time and limited washroom access. No collections or processions. Funerals and weddings and baptisms may all be celebrated in the church with the above limits and protocols. We are awaiting some updates from the Ontario Bishops which will give us more details about this third step and reopening. We hope to see a lessening of these protocols as the summer continues.
