We hope to do this with a Spirit of Christian generosity that brings us closer to the blessing of unity, peace and reconciliation.



FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME-C

<u>July 10, 2022</u>



The parable of the Good Samaritan is one of our Lord's best-known short stories. When a lawyer approaches Jesus inquiring as to who his neighbor is, Jesus directs his attention to what is a good neighbor entails. He paints a portrait of a man who was robbed on the road from Jerusalem to Jericho and beaten. The Priest and the Levite passed by on the other side of the road because to touch the dead body would have meant their exclusion from religious service in the Temple. Their brand of worship was not inspired by the love of neighbor but by religious duty. The unlikely hero of the story turns out to be a Samaritan acting out of sheer love and generosity. He opened his heart and recognized a neighbor even as a despised Jew.

Imperfect men and troubled by sin; on the one hand, we are not sure what is good and right, and on the other hand, we often happen to be unprepared to do good. This is why God gave us the commandments: they point out what is right and make each person feel what they should do. This is why the Jews of the old covenant had established a system of more than five hundred commandments and prohi-



bitions, which was supposed to enable them to do God's will in everything because they no longer had a clear vision of what was essential in God's eyes and got lost in the details. For the doctors of the law, discussing hierarchies and commandments was often far more important than the institutions designed to fulfill God's will truly. This is what the example of the doctor of the law trying to make a fool of Jesus shows: by asking him a seemingly sincere question. He wants to prove that he is an amateur theologian. But Jesus does not play along. Instead, he forces the doctor of the law to give the right answer himself and then shows him which neighbor each person should love as himself: it is the one who is in misery and need of our help. This spares any saccharine discussion around whether someone who is not a Jew or is a sinful Jew has the right to expect our support. He goes even further, showing that a Samaritan to be despised (in the eyes of the doctors of the law) can do good naturally by following the voice of his heart. But, at the same time, two pious Jews are disdainfully disinterested. So let us not forget that Jesus repeatedly emphasizes to the doctor of the law, "Act on the main commandment, and you will deserve eternal life!"

VISIT OF POPE FRANCIS TO CANADA: It has been confirmed by the Vatican that Pope Francis will be visiting Canada from July 24-29, 2022. He will be celebrating a special Mass in Edmonton & in Quebec city. He will be meeting with residential school survivors in Edmonton & will be sharing in a special prayer service at a former residential school. We await the words of Pope Francis for Canada & for the Indigenous people of our land & we pray that his trip to Canada will be peaceful, healing & successful. Please keep Pope Francis in your prayers for this important pastoral journey.
