We hope to do this with a Spirit of Christian generosity that brings us closer to the blessing of unity, peace and reconciliation.



#### **RICH IN THE EYES OF GOD**

The essential message of today's Gospel is so clear that it needs no interpretation: "Beware and keep yourselves from all covetousness, for a man's life does not depend on his possessions." And "get rich before God!" But since gaining possessions is a fundamentally human aspiration, it is therefore worth going into the details of the parable of the rich fool told by



Jesus. Wealth gives men certain security, allows them to dispose of their own lives, not to depend completely on others or the state, to organize their sphere of life, to occupy themselves with things that please them, to actualize great missions or great purposes. To this extent, goods are necessary for a right existence. Jesus does not question the good use of goods and riches. But he affirms that goods and riches lead men to feel distant from God and neighbor, to think they are insured against misery, old age and death, and to satisfy the pleasures of this world. And still, for many men, material success is a symbol of God's blessing. They think they have fulfilled their role in a life well when they acquire wealth and consideration. And that God cannot demand more from them. Even for them, the main commandment is the last criterion allowing them to judge their lives. That is why wealth must be a means of action for everyone: engaging with others. By helping those in distress and sharing generously, one will be truly rich: rich in the eyes of God.
