We hope to do this with a Spirit of Christian generosity that brings us closer to the blessing of unity, peace and reconciliation.



BE READY

In this Gospel passage, Christ tells us not to be afraid, not to allow ourselves to be distressed: our state of mind always must be a quiet trust in God, for "it has pleased your Father to give you his kingdom." So we must open an account in this kingdom, for only there is true wealth to be



found. Man's motivation and purpose always come from where he thinks true values are found: "For where your treasure is, there your heart will also be." This priority implies that we are detached from money and material goods and that we use them for the good of others, being responsible before God for their stewardship. We must also keep ourselves in a state of constant vigil, waiting for the coming of Christ: "Be ready, with your belts at your sides and your lamps burning." Just as servants do not know when their master will return from the wedding reception, just as a man cannot know when thieves will enter his house, so we do not know the hour of our death, that is, when Christ will return for us.
