## THE RIGHT WAY - GOD'S WAY

"Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted." The great teachers say that it would be best not to set humility as a goal right away. To set this goal from the beginning is to slip imperceptibly into a subtle "sufficiency." This can later lead to an excessive consideration of oneself, whereas humility consists essentially in turning one's gaze outside oneself, to-



ward Jesus and toward the great realities of faith, such as the greatness of God and the littleness of man, eternity and the narrowness of time, the hope of heaven and the threat from our weaknesses, the beauty of holiness and the horror of sin. "He who humbles himself will be exalted." To become humble, one must begin to love. That is what Jesus did. Merciful love brought him down from heaven. Love drove him onto the roads of Palestine. Love led him to seek out the sick, the sinners, the suffering. The same love led him, without delay, to his goal, Calvary, where he "humbled himself by becoming obedient unto death and death on a cross" (Phil. 2:8). Humility was the external form of his divine charity and its external companion. Humility was an attitude peculiar to the holy Mother who, because of her purity, was pleasing to God and, because of her humility, drew God to herself, for God "resists the proud; to the humble he gives his grace instead" (Jas. 4:6). Mary was humble because she loved the will of God and the people around her. "He who humbles himself will be exalted." How can we put this phrase from the Gospel into practice? We should set as our goal the primordial charity of the Gospel and try to serve everyone we meet. Each person is our Lord, and in each of them we have the privilege of serving Jesus.
