HE RECEIVES SINNERS

"All publicans and sinners came up to him to hear him. The Pharisees and scribes murmured, 'He receives sinners and eats with them.' Then he told them this parable..." Jesus tells the three parables of the lost found to an audience of murmurers. What new idea of God do they reveal to us? The parables are undoubtedly the most shocking be-



cause they teach us that God cares about what is lost and takes great joy in finding what is lost. Moreover, God faces criticism for standing on the side of the lost: the father faces his eldest son's wrath with love, peace, and no apology. Jesus faces criticism to the point of being slandered, criticism that is reproduced continuously and almost infallibly. Because every time the Church replays the image of God seeking the lost, unease arises. And again, God is interested in even one missing person. The parables of the lost sheep and the woman who toils so much over one lost drama have the paradoxical quality of pointing to the mystery of God being interested even in one lost, insignificant, worthless one from whom there is no good to be gained. This does not mean we should neglect the many; however, it is a hyperbolic image of the Lord's incomprehensible love. This is why Christian ethics reaches very demanding heights, which we do not always understand because we cannot get a clear idea of the absolute dignity of man at every stage and condition of his life.
