

INTENSITY & GRATUITOUSNESS OF THE FAITH

It is a widespread evil among believers to regard faith as a purely intellectual attitude, as the mere acceptance of certain truths. That is a faith that translates into a theoretical stance without real impact on life. Hesitation in the face of daily difficulties is often insurmountable and says that we are not sufficiently rooted in God. The two short parables in the Gospel text remind us of two properties of faith: intensity and gratuitousness. To emphasize the value of a minimal but sol-



id faith, Christ insists on the effects it can produce: changing of place even to the most deeply rooted tree. To insist on faith as God's gift, he brings the example of the servant who places the service of his love before providing for his own needs. Of course, we can never forget that the difficulties in our always support God's grace.
