Lent: time to train ourselves.

Stage I of Lent leads us into the desert. Mark's very concise Gospel passage consists of two parts: the account of Jesus' temptations and the proclamation of the kingdom of God. Jesus is thrust into the desert by



the same Spirit that descended upon him at the baptism in the Jordan. In the desert, he undergoes the temptations of Satan, whose purpose is to divide and separate from others, especially from God. The temptations, that Jesus faces at the beginning of his mission (not described by Mark), are indicative of all the difficulties that will mark his life. Jesus is ready for a mission and proclaims the kingdom of God. He begins from Galilee, a difficult place where different religious realities coexist. Fortified by the desert experience, Jesus does not desist in the face of any mission difficulty. Every Christian, to overcome temptations, like Jesus, is called to live Lent as an opportunity to train himself to face the difficulties of life, trusting God and his word.
