

# The Most Holy Trinity

## June 11, 2017

Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was, and who is to come.



We often begin Mass with the prayer from today's Epistle: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you." We praise the God who has revealed himself as a Trinity, a communion of persons. Communion with the Trinity is the goal of our worship—and the purpose of the salvation history that begins in the Bible and con-

tinues in the Eucharist and sacraments of the Church. The memory of God's covenant testing of Abraham—and Abraham's faithful obedience—lies behind today's Gospel. God was preparing us for the fullest possible revelation of His love for the world. As Abraham was willing to offer Isaac, God did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for us all. Jesus humbled himself to die in obedience to God's will. And for this, the Spirit of God raised Him from the dead, and gave Him a name above every name. This is the name we glorify in today's Responsorial Psalm the name of our Lord, the God who is Love and always will be forever and ever. Amen.

## ST. ANTHONY FEAST Sunday, June 11

Today we celebrate our patron Saint. St. Anthony was born in Lisbon, Portugal. His original name was Ferdinand. He entered the seminary as a teen-He was ordained a ager. priest with the Augustinians. He later travelled to Italy, met St. Francis of Assisi and became a Franciscan friar. He was an accomplished biblical scholar. A great preacher and advocate of the poor. St. Anthony died in Padua, Italy. He was only 36 years old.
