"I am a mission on this Earth and that is the reason why I am here in this world"



In today's Gospel, James and John ask to be given seats of honor when Jesus enters into his glory. They want to share Jesus' glory, but do not appear to understand that his glory will be preceded by his suffering. Jesus notes their lack of understanding and predicts the suffering they will endure for the sake of the Gospel. Jesus explains the importance of service and sacrifice in the life of a disciple. In particular, he seems to be preparing the Twelve for their leadership roles in the

emerging Christian community. Following Jesus' example of sacrificial love continues to be countercultural in our day as well. We might take this opportunity to consider our models of authority and examine our own exercise of authority. On whose example do we model our leadership?

Why do we sit during the proclamation of the reading:



In 1960, Pope John XXIII issued a clarification the rubrics for the Mass. He asked that the readings all be proclaimed in a clear voice. By this time it was becoming customary for people to hear the scriptures in the vernacular. The readings should be proclaimed from the ambo. The assembly, which has been standing, changes its posture

and sits. However, the Order of the Mass clarifies that the people do not merely sit. They "sit and listen."

Our goal is **\$29,000.00** and to date we have reached **40%** having raised \$11,675.00 so far. This campaign runs from September to mid December.

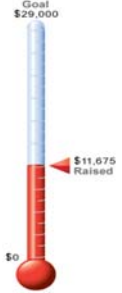
