Come follow me, says the Lord, and I will make you fishers of people.



In today's Gospel Simon Peter becomes a follower of Jesus. He calls Jesus "Lord"—the title given to Jesus after his Resurrection. Two of Simon's partners are also named as witnesses: Zebedee's sons, James and John. Yet Jesus' words are addressed only to Simon. Jesus gives Simon a new job, telling him that he will become a different kind of fisherman. No longer will he catch fish; instead he will catch people. In these words, we hear the beginning of the leadership role that Peter will have within the community of disciples. His task will be to bring others to Jesus. We continue to speak of Peter's leadership and influence in the Church today when we call the pope the "successor of Peter." We participate in the mission of the Church when we bring people to Christ through the example and positive influence of faith and action in our lives
