TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – B

I will walk before the lord, in the land of the living.

In the presentation of the life and ministry of Jesus found in the Gospel of Mark, the deeds of Jesus have shown Jesus to be the Son of God. Yet many, including Jesus' disciples, have not yet realized his identity. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks the disciples for a field report by asking what others say about him. He then

turns the question to the disciples and asks what they believe. Peter speaks for all of them when he announces that they believe Jesus to be the Christ. Christ is the Greek translation of the Hebrew word for Messiah, which means "the anointed one." At the time of Jesus, the image of the Messiah was laden with popular expectations.

WHO IS HE?



Even today we hear the most conflicting voices and judgments about Jesus: some consider him a sage, a generous moralist, a protagonist of history, and some slander him, those who hate him. But the one, identity of Jesus is the one proclaimed by Peter: "You

are the Christ." If we reduce Christian faith to the enclosure of a human horizon, however noble, we are mistaken that Christ came to bring eternal salvation, not a doctrine. It is not enough to recognize Jesus as the Son of God: we must imitate him in what he has most specifically, namely in love, which is not the end, but the necessary means to accomplish redemption. If we want to be coredeemers, we must love and participate in Christ's resurrection.
