

THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – B

November 17, 2024

Be alert at all times, praying that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man.

In today's Gospel, Jesus continues teaching his disciples about signs to look for that will indicate that the coming of the Son of Man is near. Jesus offers the lesson of the fig tree, a parable that teaches that if one knows how to read the signs, one can be prepared for the end times. Jesus also teaches, however, that no one knows when the end time will

come, except the Father. In the verses that follow this reading in Mark's Gospel, Jesus continues to warn his disciples to be on watch for this end time. Jesus' words are not spoken to frighten his disciples, nor should they frighten us. Rather, they are offered to prepare us for the changes we will experience for the end times.

Let us be ready



When you ask a child of the second half of the twentieth century what the end of the world is for him, he answers in terms of catastrophe and annihilation, just as the atomic bomb and pollution suggest. But when Je-

sus is asked about the end times, he answers in terms of fullness and return. He emphatically affirms that the Son of Man will return; not, as he has already come, to announce the kingdom (Mk 1:15) and the time of mercy (Jn 3:17), but so that all may be fulfilled (1 Cor 15:28). Jesus' preaching is charged with this concern: to open people's eyes to the premonitory signs of this end of the world, which will not be a fall into nothingness but an entrance into glory. But what remains and will remain hidden is the date of this instant. The only thing that matters is to know that this return of Christ will be there and that we must prepare for it.


