What are we to do?

John the Baptist's prophetic announcement finds an echo in those who hear him. They come to him to ask, "What are we to do?" John does not demand the harshness of the life he leads; he does not even disapprove of the activities proper to the laity who



go to him. However, he knows how to point out to each person what he should convert in himself, and how to carry out his duties toward his neighbour. When asked if he is the Messiah, John the Baptist answers no. With humility he proclaims that the Messiah is on earth and that he alone possesses true baptism. This will not be done with water, but with the Holy Spirit and fire, for all who want to experience complete conversion. Only the Messiah will be able to gather the wheat and burn the straw, to dictate the judgment of mercy.
