SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

March 16, 2025

Transfiguration in the exodus of life.

In the Transfiguration, Jesus is referred to as man's true hope and as the apogee of the Old Testament. Luke speaks of Jesus' "exodus," which contains at the same time death and resurrection. The three apostles, overcome by sleep, which represents man's inability to penetrate the Mystery, are awa-



kened by Jesus, that is, by grace, and see his glory. The cloud, a symbol of God's immensity and presence, covers them all. The three apostles hear the Father's words defining the Son as the chosen one: "This is my Son, the chosen one, listen to him." The Glory, Moses and Elijah, disappear. There remains "but Jesus alone," the only truth, the only life and the only way of salvation in the daily web of human history. This vision will help them grow in faith at the time of trial before and after the resurrection. But the memory of this vision will also help them understand "that through the passion we can come to the triumph of the resurrection."
