FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

April 6, 2025

Return to me with all your heart, says the Lord, for I am gracious and merciful.

Jesus, after writing on the ground with his finger, addresses those who stand before him and suggests that the one without sin cast the first stone. Jesus then returns to his writing. This Scripture reading is the only evidence we have of Jesus' writing. Yet there are no specific details about what he wrote. For example, we can easily imagine the scene where the Pharisees and the elders disperse. Left alone with the woman, Jesus sends the woman on her way, refusing to pass judgment on her and encouraging her to avoid future sin. Redeemed by Jesus' compassion, we are sent to sin no more and live in God's love and peace.

The power of forgiveness

Dying on the cross. It is a "scandal to the Jews, folly to the pagan peoples." Earlier Jesus had already told his disciples about the cross, which astonished and confused them. Generally man uses the weakness of others to assert his own power. But Jesus



tells his disciples, "The kings of the nations ... and those who have power over them call themselves benefactors. For you, however, let it not be so" (Luke 22:25). The Pharisees who pretend to use a poor woman, caught in the act of adultery, to compromise Jesus actually give him an opportunity to teach his new methods by example. "Let him who is without sin among you cast the stone first. Jesus emphasizes forgiveness. He teaches the crowds that there is no greater manifestation of power than forgiveness. Death itself has no such great power. In fact, only the power of Christ, who dies crucified out of love, is capable of giving life. And only the power that serves to give life is true power.
