PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSON OF THE LORD

April 13, 2025

Blessed are you who have come to us so rich in love and mercy.

This Sunday, known as Palm or Passion Sunday, marks the beginning of Holy Week. Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday are collectively known as the Triduum, a three-day period that marks the culmination of the Church year. There are two Gospels proclaimed at today's Mass. The first Gospel proclaimed before the procession with palms tells of Jesus's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. Riding on a borrowed colt, Jesus was hailed by the crowds as they shouted blessings and praise to God. This event is reported in each of the four Gospels.
