The parable, of course, does not praise the farmer because he is dishonest, but because he has the clarity and determination to take the only path to salvation that lies before him. It speaks of eternal salvation. Therefore, Jesus reproaches us for being more ready to save our-



selves from worldly evils than from eternal evil. We begin our Masses by confessing the sins we have committed. A decisive "test" of the authenticity of our Christian decision is precisely the use of money. Wealth is not dishonest, nor is external wealth a curse. But wealth is dishonest when it becomes an idol, when it distorts the heart and mind, which want at all costs to be producers of power and therefore of economic power. We must decide to choose either mammon or God. There is only one way to free ourselves from the slavery of wealth: to make "friends" through what we have, that is, through a commitment to sharing in solidarity.


